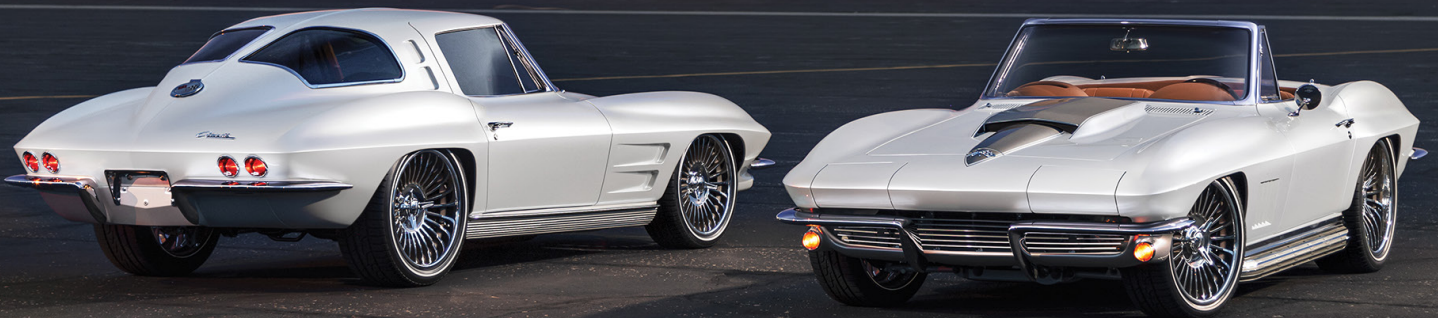

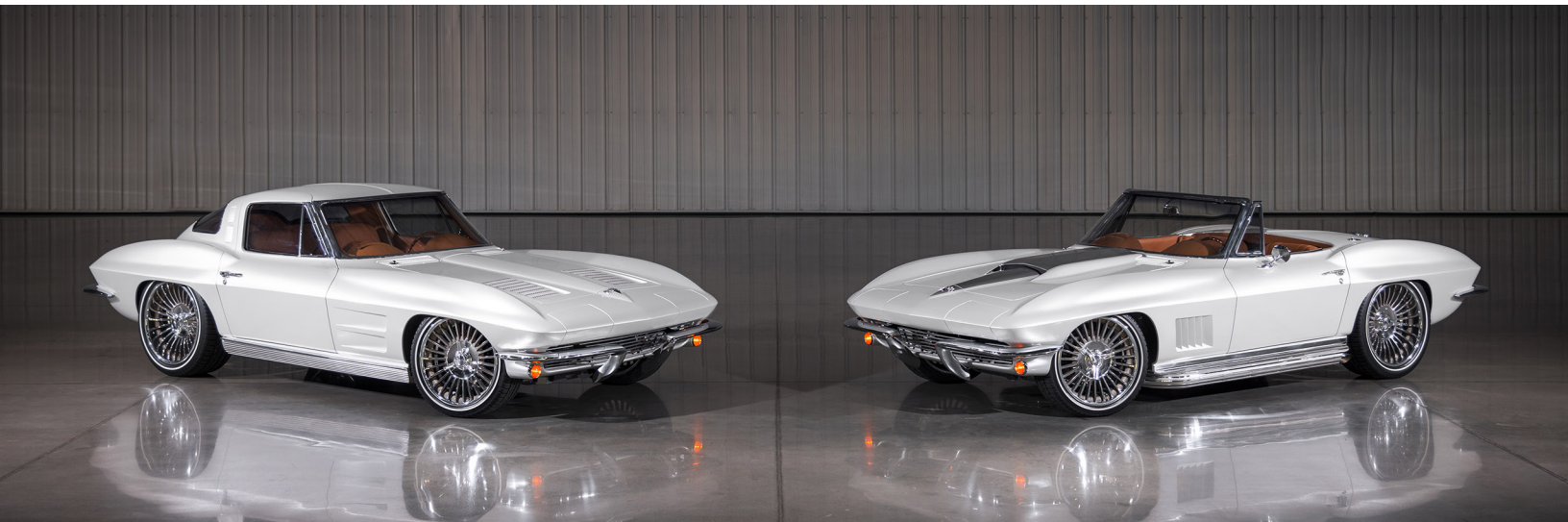

Now in its seventh year, the 2025 Arizona Concours d'Elegance will be hosted at the newly renovated Scottsdale Civic Center. This annual event has a focus on automotive design, with this year's theme being "The Art of Engineering."

Judging and exhibition will occur in 16 classes, including Pre-War Sports and Race Cars, The Iconic Engineering of Ettore and Jean Bugatti, RUF Automobile, Engineering on Two Wheels, and Trans Am – The Glory Years. More than 100 collector vehicles and motorcycles will be invited to attend, each vying for the coveted Best in Show award.

On the day before the concours, organizers will host the Saturday Seminars program in the Scottsdale Civic Center Library Auditorium, with educational talks on a variety of topics. Information on seminars will be added to the event website shortly.

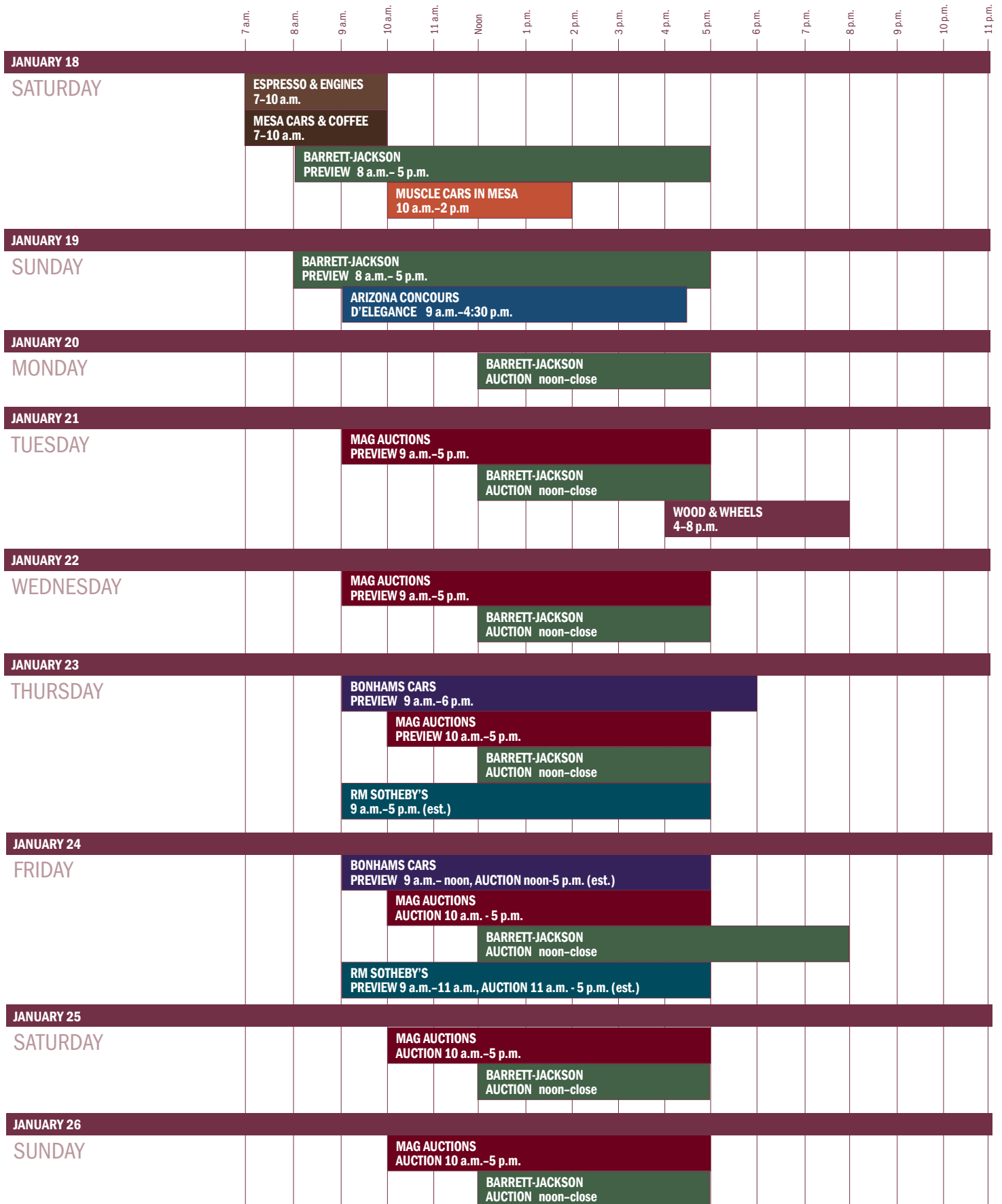
